He will offer:

4. YOU LOVE GOD BUT FEEL UNKNOWN TO HIM

You serve, you give, you pray, but still feel distant. Why? Because identity is not just about doing for God; it's about becoming who He wrote.

5. YOU KEEP ATTRACTING PEOPLE WHO MISUSE OR MISUNDERSTAND YOU

People discern the version of you you're projecting, not the one God authored. Misalignment attracts misassignment.

6. DOORS ARE OPENING, BUT PEACE IS MISSING

Opportunities can come from both God and the enemy. Discernment is knowing which one aligns with your scroll.

- 2. Renounce false selves
- 3. Ask for the scroll

- 5. Submit to scroll-carriers
- 6. Slay counterfeit scripts
- 7. Walk in prophetic obedience

FINAL REFLECTION

You were not born to freestyle life.

You were sent to fulfill what was written

Your scroll is not buried in heaven. It's waiting in your spirit. And every step of obedience makes it louder, clearer, and stronger.
