

Chapter 1: What Is a Yoke?

In the natural, a yoke is a wooden beam fastened over the necks of two animals to keep them walking in the same direction. It controls their pace, limits their movement, and ensures they do not break rank. The moment the yoke is placed on them, their will is surrendered to a system.

In the spirit realm, a yoke functions the same way. It is a spiritual mechanism of control. It does not always manifest as visible suffering. Sometimes, it disguises itself as emotional heaviness, mental oppression, compulsive behavior, or chronic limitation. A yoke doesn't just restrict, it directs.
